



**PROJECT OVERVIEW:**

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) started construction on the I-295/Malcolm X Interchange Improvement Project on September 5, 2018.

The planned improvements will be made between Fifth Sterling Ave. SE, on the north, and the South Capitol Street/Martin Luther King, Jr. Ave. SE intersection to the south. The project scope of work includes bridges, retaining walls, reconfiguration of interchanges, storm drainage, lighting, extensive landscaping, continuous shared use path, and other related improvements.

The DDOT team will communicate with residents, ANC Commissioners, civic organization leaders, businesses, and other stakeholders to provide periodic updates on the status of the project.

**KEY DESIGN ELEMENTS:**

- Provide Access to the Department of Homeland Security Headquarters
- Facilitate Access to Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling (JBAB)
- Increase motorist safety by bringing the Interchange up to AASHTO and DDOT Standards
- Add I-295 Southbound Access to/from Malcolm X Avenue
- Improve Access to Community Resources
